



English Punt

A punt is a dandy boat for duck hunting, fishing, or hauling wood or supplies to camp. It can be poled, skulled, or rowed like a regular row-boat. To skull, place your skulling oar in the hole on the stern. A back-and-forth side motion will propel the boat forward.

Some of the best woods for building small boats are white pine, white cedar, or cypress. The sides should be $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch dressed boards, so if you are going to plane them down yourself, get the boards thick enough in the first place to allow for this.
